

Washington State partners with Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to serve the healthcare needs of individuals facing economic and social barriers. MCOs align with state requirements to deliver a higher standard of healthcare.



This partnership leads to higher quality care and improved health outcomes for members enrolled in Medicaid, while managing Medicaid costs.
